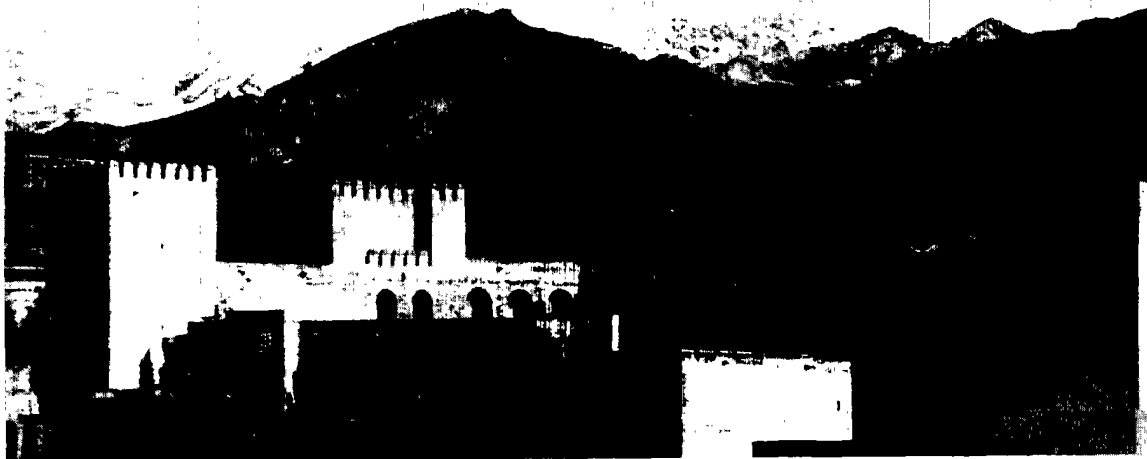

The inaugural session will be on Monday evening, May 3. Sessions on all other days will begin at 8:00 AM and end at 5:30 PM. The lectures will concentrate on controversial topics and recent developments on the various disease entities, and will emphasize the MSKCC approach towards these subjects. All lectures and discussions will be in English.

The Registration fee is \$850 (\$500 for pathologists-in-training; certificate by Program Director required). This includes attendance at all lectures, syllabus with Kodachrome slides, daily buffet luncheon, refreshment breaks, reception, and cocktail-buffet. The deadline for registration at the fees listed above is December 31, 1998. Early registration is strongly advised. Applications will be accepted on a first-received basis.
